CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS an employee of the Ministry of Forests made stumpage rate determinations under section 105 of the *Forest Act* with respect to Woodlot W0545, Cutting Permit Z, by way of two Stumpage Advisory Notices dated October 29, 2004 and November 30, 2004, and four Stumpage Adjustment Notices dated October 29, 2004;

AND WHEREAS the Appellant has appealed those determinations;

AND WHEREAS the Appellant and the Respondent agree to conclude the appeals by way of a consent order of the Forest Appeals Commission;

NOW THEREFORE the Forest Appeals Commission orders, by consent and pursuant to its powers under section 149 of the *Forest Act*, RSBC 1996, c. 157:

1. The stumpage determinations in the October 29, 2004 and November 30, 2004 Stumpage Advisory Notices be rescinded.
2. The stumpage determinations in the October 29, 2004 Stumpage Adjustment Notices be rescinded.
3. The matters appealed be referred back to the Appraisal Co-ordinator with directions.
4. The Appraisal Co-ordinator be directed to calculate stumpage rates on the basis that, subject to Amendment #12 to the Interior Appraisal

Manual, rates be reappraised on their anniversary dates occurring on November 1, 2003 or later.

5. The Appraisal Co-ordinator be directed to calculate stumpage rates on the basis that those rates fixed before a reappraisal continue to be fixed after reappraisal.
