

## **Appointment and Compensation**

## **Appointment**

The Board is made up of staff of public service employees and members, who are appointed by Cabinet. The members consist of a chair, one or more vice-chairs, and other members. The Chair and Vice Chair (Service Delivery) work full-time for the Board. All other Vice Chairs and members work part-time.

The Chair holds a full-time position and is the general administrator of the Board and its office. They are responsible for the overall management, strategic planning, direction, and performance of the Board and its office. The Chair also serves as the Chair of two appeal bodies that work out of the same office: Environmental Appeal Board and Oil and Gas Appeal Tribunal.

The Chair also provides leadership for eight review/appeal bodies. The Chair encourages the fair and efficient resolution of appeals. They are responsible for administrative, human resources, and information technology/management for this group of review/appeal bodies.

The Chair is chosen based on merit. Their initial term lasts three to five years. Later terms can last up to five years.

Vice Chairs and members are responsible for fairly and efficiently deciding appeals assigned to them by the Chair. The Vice Chair(s) may fulfill some duties of the Chair, at the request of the Chair or where the Chair cannot complete their duties.

The Vice Chair (Service Delivery) leads the registry shared by the eight review/appeal bodies in the Board's office, under the direction of the Chair. The Vice Chair (Service Delivery) also provides other management and strategic direction for the Board and its office.

Cabinet appoints members and Vice Chairs to initial terms of two to four years, and may appoint them to terms lasting up to five years. These appointments are made after consultation with the Chair.

## **Compensation**

Pay for members, including the Chair, is set by the Cabinet orders that appoint them. The rates are specified in British Columbia's <u>Treasury Board Directive 1/20</u>, based on how it classifies the Board. The Board is in the third out of five categories.
